

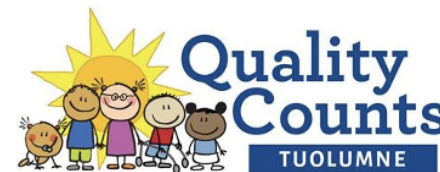

The program was rated in on the following:

	CHILD OBSERVATION	RAISING QUALITY: The program observes how children are developing.
	HEALTH & DEVELOPMENT SCREENING	ACHIEVING QUALITY: The program ensures children receive annual vision and hearing tests, and checks to see if children are developing on track.
	TEACHER TRAINING & EDUCATION	RAISING QUALITY: Teachers have 12 to 24 college units in early childhood education and development.
	EFFECTIVE TEACHER-CHILD INTERACTIONS	EXCEEDING QUALITY: The program scores high on providing: Emotional support; An organized classroom; Consistent schedules and routines; Interactions that build vocabulary, critical thinking skills and curiosity; Lessons that include children's experiences and ideas.
	TEACHER-CHILD RATIO	HIGHEST QUALITY: The program has 3 teachers for every 9 infants; 3 teachers for every 12 toddlers; 1 teacher for every 8 preschoolers and a group size less than 20.
	DIRECTOR TRAINING & EDUCATION	HIGHEST QUALITY: The Program Director has a Master's Degree with 30 college units in early childhood education and development, 8 units of management/administration, 2 units of supervision, and completes 21 hours of professional development annually.
